Aquatic Weed Spraying notification for Big Dummy and Little Dummy Lakes

The Dummy Lakes Management District (the District) proposes to chemically treat approximately 8 acres total of areas on Big Dummy and Little Dummy Lakes to control excessive weed growth that limits navigation and use of the lake. Aquatic Plant Management LLC will conduct an application of the aquatic herbicide Glyphosate and Diquat. It is anticipated that the treatment will occur sometime in July of 2025 and will proceed only after the District obtains a permit for the treatment from the Wisconsin DNR. There are no swimming, fishing or irrigation restrictions associated with the use of Glyphosate or Diquat. The District will hold a public informational meeting on the proposed treatments if five or more individuals, organizations, special units of government, or local units of government request one in writing. The person or entity requesting the meeting shall state a specific agenda of topics including problems and alternatives to be discussed. The request for a public informational meeting must be sent in writing to the Dummy Lakes Management District, P.O. Box 1303, Cumberland, WI 54829 and to the DNR, 1341 2nd Ave, Cumberland, WI 54829 within 5 days after the public notice is published.

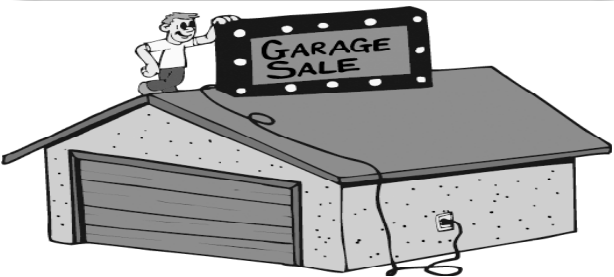
