Tom Schroeder, on behalf of the Beaver Dam Lake District, PO Box 232, Cumberland, WI 54829 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to dredge in an existing man made channel in Beaver Dam Lake. The project is located in the SE 1/4, SE 1/4, Section 01 Township 35N, Range 14W located in the City of Cumberland, Barron County.

The purpose of this project is to remove accumulated sediment that has settled in the east channel of what is locally known as Wickre Harbor. Restoring the channel to the original design that was constructed in 1964. The project consists of dredging approximately 400 lineal feet of channel to have an approximate depth of 6-feet. Over the past 58 years sediment has filled in the channel making watercraft navigation impossible. The proposal is to dredge/remove 3,812 cubic yards of sediment from the channel. The channel would have side slopes of 3 going down to an elevation of 1225.0. which would be consistent with the original de-

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.12 and 30.208, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Joshua Johnson, 1424 22nd Ave, Rice Lake, WI, 54868, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to place rock riprap on the shoreline of Beaver Dam Lake. The project is located in SW 1/4, SW 1/4, Section 31, Township 36N, Range 13W in the City of Cumberland, Barron County.

The proposed project is to clear and stabilize 135 linear feet of shoreline along Beaver Dam Lake with 15 cubic yards of 3-6" Dresser Traprock, installed 5- feet below the Ordinary High Water Mark on the back of the property, and up to 0.928-feet above the OHWM for storm wave protection. Filter fabric will be used under the rock to help stabilize the soil. The upper shoreline above the OHWM will be permanently vegetated by seeding with no-mow fescue and covered with erosion control netting upon project completion. A materials storage area will be set up in the front yard for disposal of materials removed from the shoreline, to be hauled away as well as delivery of the rip- rap to keep debris and dust to a minimum from entering Beaver Dam Lake. Temporary erosion fencing is already in place and will remain along the bank until the project is completed.
