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### ORDINANCE NO. 789

#### AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SUBSECTIONS 17.13(2) (a) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF CUMBERLAND RELATING TO ACCESSORY BUILDINGS REGARDING FRONT YARD/BACK YARD ON NAVIGABLE WATERS.

The Common Council of the City of Cumberland do ordain as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** - Subsection 17.13(2)(a) of the Municipal code of the City of Cumberland is hereby amended to read as follows: 17.13(2) ACCESSORY BUILDINGS, USES, STRUCTURES AND USE OF REQUIRED YARDS.

(a) Accessory buildings are not allowed in the front yard. Notwithstanding the forgoing accessory buildings are permitted to be in the front yard of lots located directly adjacent to Navigable Waters, as defined in Ordinance § 19.03(2), so long the accessory building maintains compliance with all setback requirements.

**SECTION TWO** - Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

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### ORDINANCE NO. 787

#### Regulation for Mailbox on City Road Right of Way STATE OF WISCONSIN City of Cumberland Barron County

**SECTION I - TITLE/PURPOSE**  
The title of this ordinance is the City of Cumberland Regulation for Mailbox on City Road Right of Way.

**SECTION II - AUTHORITY**  
The Common Council of the City of Cumberland has the authority under its city powers under s.62.11(5), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

**SECTION III - ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE**  
The Common Council of the City, by this ordinance, adopted notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the Common Council present and voting, provides the authority for the City to regulate the placement of mailboxes and removal of non-compliance mailboxes in the city.

**SECTION IV - DEFINITIONS**  
In this Ordinance:

- A. All new or replacement single mailboxes installed after November 1, 2023 shall meet the following minimum requirements:
  - 1. Mounted on a swinging arm with a length of 30 inches.
  - 2. Attached to a 4x4 wooden post.
  - 3. In accordance with Postal Service regulations.
- B. Any Mailbox and/or post not in use for a period of 1 year **may** be removed by the street crew.
- C. The City will only repair or replace mailboxes damaged due to direct physical contact by the city street crew and were previously in accordance with Postal Service and City regulations.
- D. The city **will not** reimburse individuals for the damage, but will repair or replace with a standard size mailbox.

**SECTION V - EFFECTIVE DATE**  
This ordinance is effective on publication.  
The city clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 62.11(4)(a), Wis. Stats.
